Purpose:

Blended Learning International will advise students how to obtain their USI to meet government funded or subsidised training contract requirements for the data provision. And ensure that the Privacy Act and Student Identifiers Act obligations and responsibilities are met. For reference, please see <u>https://www.usi.gov.au/</u>

From 1 January 2015, all students enrolled in nationally recognised training are required to have a Unique Student Identifier (USI). A USI is a reference number made up of numbers and letters. Creating a USI is free. It creates a secure online record of a student's nationally recognised training that can be accessed as required.
